



# Pre-Admission Form for DSRC Greener Pastures 2026

A Program Sponsored by Disability Services Resource Center (DSRC)

DSRC Greener Pastures 2026, is one of our Summer Special Needs Enrichment Programs (SSNEPs) and is for teenage/young adult females ages 13 to 20+ years having special needs from Bay County or BAISD students. This is a day program that will be in session for six weeks, June 15<sup>th</sup> through July 23<sup>rd</sup>, Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays at Bangor North Preschool building, 504 Revilo Road (off North State Park Drive), Bay City, MI 48706 AND THURSDAYS will be Community Experience days off-site with drop-off and pick-up locations to be announced. All days will run from 10 AM to 2 PM. This will be the 25<sup>th</sup> year of the DSRC Greener Pastures summer program! This year's theme is: "USA 250!"

DSRC Greener Pastures 2026 highlights the transition from school into the world of volunteering/work. Areas of emphasis include staying on task, work safety, following directions, completing tasks to set standards, plus appropriate social skills in a variety of different situations. The participants are also involved in recreation/physical fitness activities and community service projects. As a part of the program, hands-on/discussions are on-going relative to money such as the concept of needs/wants, purchasing of items/services,

and budgeting. Additionally, participants will be involved with the Bay County Summer Reading Program. Use of technology during DSRC Greener Pastures 2026 will also allow us to have ongoing discussions/instruction in how to safely use technology in their daily lives. Each participant will need to bring a sack lunch daily including a beverage; refrigeration is available.

These teenage/young adult females have special needs and, in most cases, learn differently than other students in traditional school settings, and may be in some type of special education program. The participants will work alongside Job Trainers - ratio of 6 teenage/young adult females per one Job Trainer. The Job Trainers' duties are to model the activities to be done, supervise the participants, give direction/guidance, as well as help them grow into being responsible, caring citizens. Admission is limited to 15 participants.

This program incorporates the use of Bay Metro Transportation, Bay County Library System, Bay City State Park, River Walk, and other local destinations to help foster a variety of experiences for these teenage/young adult females having special needs. Transportation to and from DSRC Greener Pastures 2026 is the family/guardian's responsibility for their participant; Bay Metro Transportation may be available on a limited basis at the family's own expense. Bay Metro's contact number is 989-894-2900.

Admission is based on each individual's needs and the ability of DSRC Greener Pastures 2026 staff to meet those needs. Each teenage/young adult female MUST be able to respond positively to directions given to her by someone other than a family member. Turning in this Pre-Admission Form by May 29<sup>th</sup> does not ensure the applicant's admission in DSRC Greener Pastures 2026. Each applicant's family will be notified if accepted into DSRC Greener Pastures 2026 by June 5, 2026. Families will then need to fill out several forms BEFORE attending the program including: Registration, the Medical Release/Health Examination, a Media Release, the program's Code of Conduct/Rules, etc. Admission is limited to 15 participants. Pre-Admission Forms received after May 29<sup>th</sup>, and/or if the program is filled, will be placed on a waiting list. NOTE: This program is not equipped to include participants with severe mental, emotional, physical, or multiple impairments.

Due to receiving a generous grant, we are able to again offer 96 hours (six weeks of four 4-hour days/week) of programming and keep the fee at the same rate as 2025. The program fee for DSRC Greener Pastures 2026 is \$425. Partial sponsorship funds may be available for those who have helped DSRC this past year with fundraisers or assistance at DSRC such as the 'YES I CAN Drive', weeding the flower beds, helping with mailings, etc. Payment plans are also available; contact Gail Frahm, Executive Director at DSRC, 989-895-5444 for further information. Full payment must be made prior to Monday, June 8<sup>th</sup>, unless a payment plan has been authorized/approved by Gail.
