# Pre-Admission Form for DSRC Rolling Hills 2026

A Program Sponsored by Disability Services Resource Center (DSRC)

DSRC Rolling Hills 2026, a Summer Special Needs Enrichment Program (SSNEP) for men and women ages 20+ to 36 with special needs from Bay County. This is a day program that will be in session for six weeks, June 15<sup>th</sup> through July 23<sup>rd</sup>, Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays at Bangor North Preschool building, 504 Revilo Road (off North State Park Drive), Bay City, MI 48706 AND THURSDAYS will be Community Experience days off-site with drop-off and pick-up locations to be announced. All days will run from 10 AM to 2 PM. This will be the 4<sup>th</sup> year of the DSRC Rolling Hills summer program! This year's theme is: "USA 250!"

DSRC Rolling Hills 2026 emphasizes socialization and community integration. Those enrolled need to be able to manage their own personal hygiene, be able to independently handle outings/activities, exhibit good socialization skills with peers and others, and show the ability to take positive direction given by staff. The participants will be involved with 1 or 2 Advisors, whose duties are to give direction/guidance as needed and encourage making good decisions, leading to greater independence in life skills – as well as

being a friend throughout their day! As a part of the program, hands-on/discussions are on-going relative to money ... the concepts of needs/wants, purchasing of items/services, and budgeting. Additionally, the participants are involved in daily recreation/physical fitness activities. During the program when using technology, ongoing discussions/instruction will take place in how to safely use technology in their daily lives. Each participant will need to bring a sack lunch daily including a beverage; refrigeration is available.

This program incorporates the use of Bay Metro Transportation, Bay County Library System, Bay City State Park, River Walk, and other local destinations to help foster a variety of experiences for these young adults who have special needs. Transportation to and from DSRC Rolling Hills 2026 is the family/guardian's responsibility for their participant; Bay Metro Transportation may be available on a limited basis at the family's own expense. Bay Metro's contact number is 989-894-2900.

Admission is based on each individual's needs and the ability of DSRC Rolling Hills 2026 staff to meet those needs. Each young adult MUST be able to respond positively to directions given to him/her by someone other than a family member. Turning in this Pre-Admission Form by May 29<sup>th</sup> does not ensure the applicant's admission in DSRC Rolling Hills 2026. Each applicant's family will be notified if accepted into DSRC Rolling Hills 2026 by June 5, 2026. Families will then need to fill out several forms before attending the program: Registration, the Medical Release/Health Examination, a Media Release, and agree to the program's Code of Conduct/Rules BEFORE attending the program. Admission is limited to 10 participants. Pre-Admission Forms received after May 29<sup>th</sup>, and/or if the program is filled, will be placed on a waiting list. NOTE: This program is not equipped to include participants with severe mental, emotional, physical, or multiple impairments.

Due to the availability of some grant funds, we are able to again offer 96 hours (six weeks of four 4-hour days/week) of programs at the same rate as 2025, \$425. Partial sponsorship funds may be available for those who have helped DSRC this past year with fundraisers or assistance at DSRC such as the 'YES I CAN Drive', weeding the flower beds, helping with mailings, etc. Payment plans are also available; contact Gail Frahm, Executive Director at DSRC, 989-895-5444 for further information. Full payment must be made by Monday, June 8<sup>th</sup>, unless a payment plan has been authorized/approved by Gail.
