All Children Experience Sports (ACES) Code of Conduct/Rules

- 1) Behave appropriately and be respectful of others at all times, obeying all local, state, and federal laws.
- 2) Physical contact, inappropriate touching, and horseplay are not permitted, nor are teasing, bullying, unkind behavior, intimidation, and other forms of harassment. These are not acceptable and will not be tolerated in any form during this program.
- 3) Destruction of property is strictly prohibited!
- 4) Do not use other people's sporting equipment without their permission. DSRC offers equipment for everyone to use. Any equipment borrowed must be returned after each player's turn.
- 5) Be responsible for your own belongings – only things that belong to you, leave with you. It is strongly recommended that you label your belongings.
- 6) Dress appropriately; wear a T-shirt or sweatshirt and long shorts or pants. Tops and bottoms should meet or overlap in the middle such that no skin or underwear can be seen even when bending over.
- 7) Throw your trash away in available, appropriate receptacles; don't litter.
- 8) Transportation to and from the program is the responsibility of each family/guardian.
