Dear Bowler,

We hope everyone is having a great summer! It is already time to start planning for DSRC's Wheelers & Dealers bowling season. Whether you've bowled with us in the past or not, let us know if you intend to bowl this year. We welcome both new and returning bowlers ages six and up with disabilities. Register by completing and returning the enclosed registration materials. All forms are required and must be completed and returned to DSRC by Thursday, August 27, 2026, **NO EXCEPTIONS**. Please do not show up at bowling and expect to bowl if you haven't registered and turned in all the required forms.

We are taking orders for Wheelers & Dealers team t-shirts which have the logo design on them as pictured above. The shirts will again be the bright green! See the enclosed Apparel Order Form to order and pay for your shirt. It **MUST** also be returned by noon on August 27 to ensure you have your shirt the first night of bowling. Supporter t-shirts are also available on the form.

The forms to be completed and returned include: Bowler Registration (cut off the handy schedule at the bottom and put it on your calendar), Bowling Code of Conduct-Rules, Media Release, Liability Insurance Waiver, Medical Release/Physician Examination Form (if a physical has been done in the past year, submit a copy of that one to us along with the top of the Medical Release Form completed). Most of the forms are fillable, which means you can just download the forms, save them to your computer, open each one back up, type the information into it, save them back in a folder on your computer, attach all the forms into **ONE** email message and send them back to us at dsrbcb@gmail.com. Call us if you have questions on this. **NOTE:** Some of you may have recently completed these forms for DSRC's SSNEPs (Summer Special Needs Enrichment Programs) or ACES softball (All Children Experience Sports) in which case, we will only need you to complete the Bowler Registration Form and Bowling Code of Conduct form if your Medical Release/Physician Exam Form is current within the last year.

Bowling will start Thursday, September 10th at 4:00 p.m. at Alert Lanes in Essexville. Please arrive early for sign in and warm-up. The 2026-2027 Wheelers & Dealers Bowling Schedule is at the bottom of the Registration Form. This season's bowling fee is \$9.00 per night. And, if you are absent, the fee is \$3.00. If you wish to pre-pay for the either the full season (15x\$9=\$135) or monthly (2x\$9=\$18), you are welcome to do so!! These payments would be arranged with Lisa at Alert Lanes directly.

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Wheelers & Dealers Bowling Code of Conduct/Rules

- 1) Behave appropriately and be respectful of others at all times, obeying all local, state, and federal laws.
- 2) Physical contact, inappropriate touching, and horseplay are not permitted, nor are teasing, bullying, unkind behavior, intimidation, and other forms of harassment. These are not acceptable and will not be tolerated in any form during this program.
- 3) Destruction of property is strictly prohibited!
- 4) Do not use other people's sporting equipment without their permission. The alley offers equipment for everyone to use. Any equipment borrowed must be returned in the same condition as received before leaving the alley.
- 5) Be responsible for your own belongings – only things that belong to you, leave with you. It is strongly recommended that you label your belongings.
- 6) Dress appropriately; wear a T-shirt or sweatshirt and long shorts or pants. Tops and bottoms should meet or overlap in the middle such that no skin or underwear can be seen even when bending over.
- 7) Snacks and drinks may be purchased and consumed only in the designated areas. Throw your trash away in available, appropriate receptacles; don't litter. Only water in transparent (clear) water bottles are allowed to be brought into the alley. No other beverages are allowed, nor any in translucent or opaque containers.
- 8) Follow bowling alley etiquette such as sitting at the table that most closely lines up with your bowler's lane.
- 9) Transportation to and from the program is the responsibility of each family/guardian.
